On 7th March, the Cairngorm Brewery based in Aviemore in the Highlands of Scotland won Best Bitter at the SIBA National Beer Competition. Having already won the Scottish round in June 2007, "Trade Winds" (our flagship beer) went onto win the overall UK award in a contest involving nearly 350 breweries.

Sean Tomlinson, Head Brewer and newly appointed Operations Director said "the Brewery's sales continue to grow strongly in the local

area and the brewery continues to gain many converts to the delights of these well crafted distinctive beers drunk in good pubs with good company".

Cairngorm Brewery in the heart of the Cairngorms National Park has a full range of permanent and seasonal cask beers to suit all tastes and 8 of our products are available throughout the year in 500 ml bottles. Currently a 10 barrel brewery, producing 360 gallons of the finest ales each day (and quite often twice a day) will be upgraded to a 20 barrel operation, due to high demand for our products.
